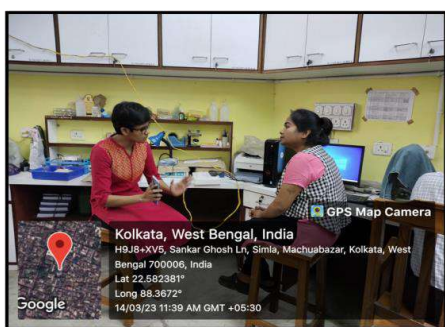

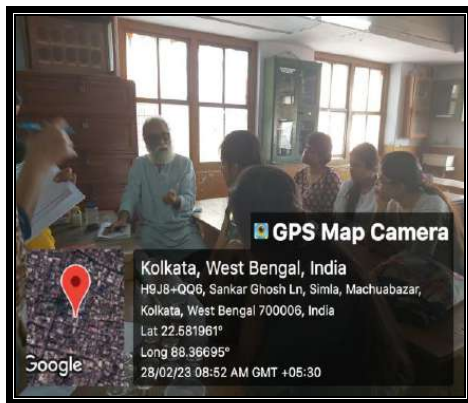

- The program successfully matched 4 mentors with 27 students based on shared interests, academic goals, and career aspirations.
- Teachers worked with students to set realistic short-term and long-term goals. This process involves discussing academic aspirations, identifying steps to achieve them, and creating action plans.
- Regular check-ins help by teachers, helped students to stay on track with their academic and personal goals.


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- The use of statistical software in teaching economics allowed students to apply abstract economic theories in real-world scenarios. It helped them understand how theoretical concepts translate into measurable variables and empirical analysis and bridge the gap between economic theory and application.
- Students were recommended to actively participation in class discussions to enhance critical thinking skills.
- All students were advised to attend online webinars of other colleges and institutes for better understanding of the subjects. For these webinars available links for different webinars were shared by respective mentors.
- Special discussion took place with semester-V students to make them more equipped with the application of programming software 'R'. This helped them acquire additional skills such as data analysis and statistical software proficiency.
- Student seminars were organized were students presenting in front of other students and teachers helped them to enhance their communication skills and taking responsibility for planning, coordinating, and leading the session.
- To ensure that students are informed about opportunities and important information even when they are not online, physical bulletin boards were displayed for important announcements, upcoming events, and academic resources.
- Regular feedback was sought from both mentors and students through surveys and informal discussions.
- Modelling positive behaviors, ethical values, and a passion for learning helps students develop their own values and aspirations, influencing students in both academic and personal aspects of their lives.
- Students were guided about their possible carrier opportunities. Department suggested them these opportunities individually and also collectively.
